Al Ain University is a Packing House for “Ramadan Aman 8”

As a packaging house in the city of Al Ain for the campaign “Ramadan Aman 8”, Al Ain University of Science and Technology is receiving a huge number of volunteers who are participating in the campaign, which was launched by the Al Ihsan Charity Association, In Partnership with the Ministry of Interior and in cooperation with the Traffic departments and police, and the Emirates Red Crescent. This campaign contributes to reduce traffic accidents and over speed through distributing meals to drivers at Maghreb prayer timings, With the participation of thousands of volunteers.

Approximately 3,000 boxes are filled every day, and 2,000 boxes are distributed on four traffic lights, Al Jimi Mall, Al Marbuba, Al Maqam Palace and Al Ain Palace.
